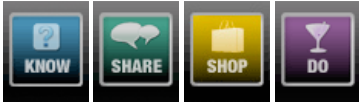

## City of Tybee Island NOTICE OF PROPERTY TAX INCREASE

The City of Tybee Island has tentatively adopted a millage rate which will require an increase in property taxes by 11.5 percent. All concerned citizens are invited to the public hearings on this tax increase to be held at City Hall, 403 Butler Ave, Tybee Island, GA on July 24 at 6:30 p.m. and 7:00 p.m.

### Explanation of Notice of Property Tax Increase

The “Notice of Property Tax Increase” must be written as presented above to meet the requirements of Georgia law; however, it should be clarified that the Tybee Island City Council has not tentatively adopted a millage rate that would require an increase in property taxes. Use of the phrase “tentatively adopted” applied on to the legal notice as the city council has taken no action on adopting a millage (tax) rate.
